MISHAP REPORTING AND REVIEW

CAP Regulation 62-2, dated 20 May 2014, Mishap Reporting and Review is Supplemented as follows:

3.a Added: In the event of a mishap arising out of Civil Air Patrol activities, an appropriate CAP member (e.g. unit commander, activity director, safety officer, pilot –in- command, ranking senior member) will immediately **(within two-hours of a mishap)** notify the following in the order listed below until one person is reached:

Director of Safety	Lt Col Wally Jaynes
Asst. Director of Safety	Lt Col Robert Becka
Chief of Staff	Lt. Col. Fred Staedel
Vice Commander	Lt Col Carswell Ross Jr.
Commander	Col Patrick Collins

The person contacted will notify the remainder on the list, and the CAP Pacific Region staff as required by Pacific Region Supplement to CAPR 62-2. In addition, for incidents involving serious injury, death or property damage, CAP-USAF PLR will be notified via LtCol Kevin Cummings, Det 8 CAP-USAF PLR/DO, or Mr. Ed Gelzinis, Det 8 CAP-USAF PLR/ADO.

3.b. Added: The above notice does not replace the notification required under paragraph 4.a., Accidents. If a mishap occurs at a CAP activity that could be serious enough to classify as an accident, the unit / activity commander must immediately notify the CAP National Operations Center (NOC) toll free at 888-211-1812, extension 300.
